To All Competitors: We would like to take this time to remind everyone that within the MIR Track Procedures the following is provided for:

“C.) Any member or participant that verbally abuses any MIR official or MIR employee will be subject to disqualification and/or fine and/or suspension and/or legal action and/or probation or/any other action deemed appropriate by MIR Official or Super DIRTcar Series and/or DIRTcar Officials and/or World Racing Group Supervisory Officials. Minimum = \$ 0; Maximum = \$2500”

This language is very similar to that which appears in the DIRT Motorsports Rulebook (See 11.1 C.).

We bring this to everyone’s attention as in recent weeks the number of complaints from numerous competitors often using vulgar and profane language directed at MIR Officials has increased four-fold. At MIR we have universally tried to be ‘racer-friendly’ and openly acknowledge that racing is a sport that requires a huge time and monetary commitment and with that can come some heated reactions, both physical and verbal. However, we have also strived to not permit our officials to engage in equally heated reactions. For some, they have taken this as license to heap even more vulgar and profane language to an even higher pitch. The procedures of the track, as well as the DIRT Rulebook, permit disciplinary action in such contexts. But again, at MIR we understand that taking disciplinary action can only make participation in this sport even more difficult. However, this should not be read to assume that the tolerance of such conduct and language is unlimited.

Therefore, we take this time to remind all competitors of the foregoing rules as we hope to not have to exercise their use. Furthermore, we also remind all competitors that there is in fact an appeal process provided for in the Track Procedures, and that this should be utilized prior to heaping any verbal abuse on any MIR Officials or Staff, or anyone for that matter.
